## Self Catering Holiday Bungalow

Lochcarron, Wester Ross



Comfortable modern 2-bedroom bungalow in quiet semi-rural position,  
but within a short distance of all village amenities.



T arlogie is a small modern 2 bedroom bungalow with accommodation for up to 4 people, and is well suited to couples and small families.

T he sleeping accommodation comprises one double bedroom and one twin room.

T here is a comfortable lounge to the front of the property, a well equipped kitchen with a table and 4 chairs, and a shower room with WC .

T he bungalow has full oil-fired central heating throughout.

O utside, there is a large open-plan garden area with patio furniture, and ample off-road parking space for 2 or 3 cars.

Last, but not least, is the view which can only be described as stunning! T he photo to the right



shows this view as seen from just behind T arlogie. A lthough the bungalow is situated away from the main part of Lochcarron village, there is quick access on foot to the shops, pub, restaurant, bank, etc.



Lochcarron is situated on the West Coast of Scotland, 63 miles due west of Inverness, and lies amidst magnificent Highland scenery, some of the finest in the British Isles.

To the right is a view of the village from the south shore of Lochcarron, with the snow-capped mountains of A pplecross in the background.



Lochcarron is an excellent centre for touring. To the immediate north and west lies the A pplecross peninsula which is approached via the Bealach na Ba, the Pass of the Cattle, one of the highest roads in Britain. This road climbs from sea level to a height of 2,053 feet, and provides some spectacular views along the way.



A 20-minute walk from the car park at the summit affords some even more magnificent views in all directions, especially towards the Isles of S kye and Raasay to the west. The photo to the left shows the view down towards K ishorn from the A pplecross tops.

A little further to the north and west are the T orridon Hills, always a favourite area for walkers and climbers, and the Beinn E ighe National Nature Reserve; also, beautiful Loch Maree, and Gairloch with its lovely white sandy beaches and links' golf course. Further north up the coast from Gairloch are Inverewe Gardens which, despite being on a latitude more northerly than Moscow, contain exotic plants from all over the world, courtesy of the Gulf S tream.

To the south and west are Loch A lsh and the new S kye Bridge, and the magnificent scenery of Glenelg (with its Pictish brochs) and Kintail. The road over to Glenelg via Mam Ratagan provides, once again, some very spectacular views. Nearer to Lochcarron are the pretty villages of S hieldaig and Plockton, and the gardens at A ttadale just across the loch. Lochcarron is surrounded by excellent walking country with many magnificent views.

T arlogie is available to let right throughout the year, and the prices for 2012 are as follows:-

Tarlachie is located in Croft Road, a very quiet semi-rural side road on the edge of Lochcarron village.

Lochcarron is reached from the south by one of two main routes:-

- A 9 north from Inverness, thence via the A 835 to Garve, the A 832 to Achnasheen, and finally the A 890/A 896 to Lochcarron.
- From Fort William via the A 82 north to Invergarry, and then via the A 87 (towards Kyle of Lochalsh) and the A 890/A 896 to Lochcarron.
